

Adult Faith Formation Class is coming soon in November (Affirmation of Baptism)! - Something that I have always wanted to try is an Adult "confirmation" class; that is, faith formation (yes, the formation we do for middle school aged kids, but for adults). We have people from all walks of life, some who have affirmed their baptism at St. John's years ago, some from other denominations, and some have never experienced that milestone. We also have people who are relatively new to the faith. Technically, we do affirm our baptism

regularly, but to go through a **time of study** before doing so has some real intentionality behind it. My plan is to offer TWO tracks for those who would like to be a part of this year's Adult Education in a new way.

First Track: This is for people who simply want to come to these classes as they choose and can, participating as they would like to, since most of the classes will occur during the usual Adult Education time. And, since it will be during the usual Adult Education time, I don't want to deny anyone wanting to attend.

Second Track: This track is for people who choose to commit to the extra time of digging deeply into some theology, readings, and continued study outside of class time. Those who commit to the second track would affirm their baptism in the season of Easter similarly to how our young people do. It will include some reflection and a few books to buy for study.

Why now? 2020 was a "blip" in time (I'm sure you can guess why). Despite best efforts, parents and kids were not feeling the confirmation vibes in 2020. They were desperately trying to do school via zoom at home and living through a pandemic. 2020 was HARD for everyone. That means we had no students commit to the confirmation track until 2021 came around. Therefore, this spring, there will be no Confirmation Day at St. John's for the usual 9th graders. Some of those kids chose to begin in 2021 instead. Therefore, it gives an opportunity to consider a similar formation for adults including understanding Martin Luther, Lutheran theology, Christian faith formation and practices, along with opening the Bible. I can't wait!

When we begin: November 10th at 10:15 AM during the Adult Education hour.

Registration is required for those who want to commit to track 2. You can find the registration page in this newsletter.



LMD primarily helps Kurdish girls in Turkey to complete their education and acquire marketable skills. The girls are famous for their beautiful hand-woven rugs. LMD has now expanded their mission to include Syrian refugee families.

"The work we've done in Turkey is a beacon of hope in the darkness of the Islamic State, al-Qaeda, and militias of the Muslim Brotherhood. In the midst of this ongoing crisis, we assist families to escape the pull of conflict and offer their children support and education".


