St. John's Endowment Fund Committee Vision Ministry Fund By-Law Change Request

The St. John's Endowment Fund (SJEF) by-laws specify the two ways to distribute funds from the endowment fund.

- 1. Annual distribution for outreach ministry based on 5% of the year-end fund balance.
- 2. Distributions from the Vision Ministry Fund.

With endorsement from the finance committee and approved by the church council, the SJEF committee recommends deletion of all references to a Vision Ministry Fund and a Vision Ministry Fund Committee in the SJEF by-laws.

For the record, the Vision Ministry Fund and Vision Ministry Fund Committee do not yet exist. The annual 5% yearly distribution for outreach ministry will continue in perpetuity.

Annual Meeting: February 23rd @ 10:15 AM Sanctuary

References to a Vision Ministry Fund in the by-laws are as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the distribution from all unrestricted gifts and bequests to the Endowment Fund shall be transferred periodically and used for outreach ministries. After being vested for a term of 33 and 1/3 years certain, each principal gift not designated in perpetuity by its giver shall be rolled-over and be placed in the Vision Ministry Fund (C.1-3), where its entire remainder is used.

- a) On the 33 1/3 anniversary of the unrestricted or planned gift or bequest, 100% of the then remaining principal shall be rolled over and placed into the Vision Ministry Fund, a separate fund of St. John's Lutheran Church, subject to paragraph B.1.d.
- d) No distribution from the asset balance shall be made to the Vision Ministry Fund that reduces the S.J.E.F. total asset balance below the sum of 10% of the annual operating budget of the congregation.

C. PLAN FOR "ROLL-OVER TO THE VISION MINISTRY FUND

C.1 At the end of a period certain, that being 33 1/3 years from the date of receipt, the remainder of each single gift principal (asset) portion of the non-designated or planned gift or bequest will be rolled-over from the St. John's Endowment fund to the St. John's Vision Ministry Fund according to B.1 a-d. C.2 These assets will then be expended by the church council in consultation with the Vision Ministry

C.3 The purpose for the transfer of these assets from the S.J.E.F. to the Vision Ministry Fund is that these funds will be used for building new ministries. These funds are not intended to be used for current operating expenses.

These items will be discussed at the upcoming Annual Meeting on February 23rd at 10:15 AM

Chippewa Valley Technical College Student Food Pantry


Some students are impacted by rising costs and face food insecurity every day. During February, Caring Ministry will collect items for the CVTC Food Pantry.


Since starting the CVTC Food Pantry in 2015, they have expanded the pantry to include the Eau Claire West campus. During 2022 to 2023 they served 610 students and distributed 5600 pounds of food and non-food items.

The food pantry is available for all current full and part-time CVTC students experiencing food insecurity while pursuing their degree.
