Job and Church Brief:

St. John's is a congregation of the ELCA which is rooted in Lutheran theology and tradition. We are called to be a fountain of life for all who gather. St. John's Lutheran Church is seeking an innovative individual who models and teaches faith while engaging children, youth and families in faith-based programming.

Essential Functions:

- Develop programs, classes, and activities for youth and families that teach the good news of Jesus and encourage service to others in His name. This is the basis of this job.
- Initiate contact and develop relationships with congregation members of all ages while highlighting work with families and youth.
- Work in cooperation with the Youth, Faith Family, and Education ministries.
- Communicate ideas and instructions clearly to staff, the congregation and the families concerning activities details, need for volunteers, service opportunities and fundraisers.
- Recruit and train adults and older youth as leaders and teachers in developed programs, acknowledging and incorporating the experiences and ideas of previous leaders and ministry members.
- Build respectful and cooperative relations with other staff members, both offering and receiving assistance as needed.
- Possess strong computer and social media skills.

- Maintain and update database, calendar, and website with office staff

- Familiar and comfortable with the Bible and Lutheran theology and practice
- Flexibility in hours and scheduling
- Ability to successfully pass a background check
- Able to move freely in and out of different ministry settings (classroom, camps, churches, etc.)
- Able to lift up to 50lbs.
- Have valid driver's license and is able to drive

Accountability and terms of employment

The Director of Children, Youth and Family Ministry's (CYF) immediate supervisor is the Pastor; the CYF is also responsible to the Personnel Committee. Performance review and goal setting will take place annually with the Personnel Committee.
